

Taylor University Online Policy & Guidelines — Please carefully read the following information before completing registration form.

- Courses taken through Taylor University Online (TUO) require the completion of the TUO course approval form. This form requires the signatures of the student's academic advisor and, when applicable, the department chair. After review, final approval is completed by the Registrar.
- No more than 12 hours of distance learning may be taken to fulfill degree requirements. The total maximum of distance learning and independent study is 16 hours.
- *Grades earned affect the cumulative GPA.* These courses are not considered part of the academic load within the regular term for enrollment verification or financial aid purposes.
- No student on institutional academic probation is permitted to register for courses through TUO unless repeating a course. No academically suspended student may be enrolled in any Taylor courses, including those offered by TUO.
- Candidates for graduation must complete all distance learning course work and exams by the date specified by the Registrar.

TAYLOR UNIVERSITY ONLINE COURSES AVAILABLE TO TAYLOR UNIVERSITY STUDENTS
