

Pre-College Dual Enrollment Program **Guidance Counselor Recommendation**

Junior and senior high school students may enrich and expand their education experiences by enrolling at Taylor University for the fall and spring semesters. Classes may not be taken for audit. Full college credit is awarded for all courses satisfactorily completed according to university-established requirements and procedures. Dual credits earned at Taylor may be evaluated for transfer by other colleges and universities.

WHO QUALIFIES

Limited to high school juniors and seniors who have at least a 3.0 grade point average, rank in the top 20% of their class, are recommended by the high school guidance counselor, and agree to abide by the Life Together Covenant.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A completed Pre-College Dual Enrollment Application
- 2. A signed Life Together Covenant
- 3. A high school guidance counselor recommendation
- 4. An official high school transcript with SAT, ACT, or CLT scores (if applicable)
- 5. The course tuition fee of \$50.00 per credit hour upon acceptance

*Not applicable to dependents of Taylor University employees

6. It is recommended that students applying to the Pre-College Dual Enrollment Program complete a full schedule at their high school in the event that Taylor University cannot accommodate the requested class(es)
