SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

I have taught a wide range of undergraduate and graduate economics and finance courses at the various colleges and universities at which I have worked over the last 28 years. Additionally, I had taught as a Teaching Assistant at the University of Tennessee while working on my doctorate, and served as an adjunct in the Adult Education programs at Indiana Wesleyan University and Concordia University, teaching a range of finance and economics courses both at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Prior to teaching, I held a Series 7 brokerage license and have served as a stockbroker at three regional firms in Denver, Colorado Springs, and in Chattanooga, Tennessee.

I have had some exposure to foreign cultures, having traveled in Greece, Honduras, Nicaragua, and Costa Rica during the summer of 1996. I traveled to Germany, Austria, Greece, Turkey, Israel, and Jordan during the summer of 1999. I have lectured on International Economics at the University of Nizhni Novgorod, Russia during the Spring breaks of 2000 and 2001. I was a Fulbright-Hays grant recipient to study and travel in the Republic of South Africa for a month during the Summer of 2000, focusing on the condition of post-Apartheid South Africa. During June of 2001 and 2002, I had the opportunity to teach at the Eastern Ukrainian Theological Seminary in Donetsk, Ukraine under the auspices of International Theological Education

Ministries. Thrice, I have taken students to Oxford for them to study there during our January term.
